## The Story

Rock Springs Wyoming was settled in the 1870s and incorporated in 1888. There were ten coal mines in the downtown area and several outlying “coal camps” that required an extensive workforce. The Union Pacific Coal Company owned the majority of the mines and recruited miners from all over the world. Rock Springs became known as the town that was the “Home of 56 Nationalities.” It was reported that Rock Springs was the second largest “Melting Pot” west of the Mississippi River, second only to San Francisco. Most of the original nationalities are still represented by descendants living in Rock Springs today.



## International Days

Every year the community of Rock Springs comes together to celebrate the City’s diverse cultural heritage and to honor the International Nights held in the earlier part of the century. Today, the festival is held in Bunning Park in Historical Downtown Rock Springs, and is a fun-filled day highlighting foods, music, costumes, and traditions of the City’s ancestors.
